MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) made and entered into this 1st day of the month of September 2016 by and

BETWEEN

CSIR-Central Building Research institute, Roorkee, (CSIR-CBRI) a constituent establishment of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and having its registered office at Anusandhan Bhawan, 2 - Rafi Marg, New Delhi – 110 001 (hereinafter called CSIR which expression shall, where the context so admits, include its representatives, successors and permitted assignees) of the FIRST part.

AND

Institute for Steel Development & Growth (INSDAG) an Institute under ministry of Steel, Government of India was incorporated under the West Bengal Society's act, and having its Registered office at 40, Chowringhee Road, Kolkata -700 071, West Bengal herein referred to as 'INSDAG' which term or expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the Context or the meaning thereof, shall include its affiliates and its successors and permitted assignees, of the SECOND PART;

Whereas CSIR-CBRI has the expertise in the field of Building Science and Technology.

CSIR-CBRI and INSDAG herein after also individually referred to as a "Party "and collectively as the "Parties";

WHEREAS, **INSDAG** is engaged to promote usage of steel for various sectors like Residential, Commercial, Infrastructure, Industrial & Rural Segment for Construction Industries

AND

WHERAS the parties have agreed to sign the MOU for implementing innovative steel structure along with the RCC foundation design to be developed jointly by INSDAG & CSIR-CBRI & other technologies developed at CSIR-CBRI, and both the parties have agreed to co-operate in using steel intensive construction and relevant technologies developed by CSIR-CBRI in any of the village to be taken up by INSDAG under CSR program of some organisation or authority, the design for which on case to case basis will be developed jointly by INSDAG & CSIR-CBRI.

AND WHERAS both the parties have agreed to share technical knowledge /information among them with a view to providing optimum design conforming to IS:800-2007 and other relevant IS codes to be used by both the parties in their various projects as and when by them.

Now therefore it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. This MoU outlines the modalities and general conditions governing the co-operation between the parties.
- 2. INSDAG shall discuss with CSIR-CBRI, whenever services of CSIR-CBRI are required by them.
- 3. CSIR-CBRI will provide the expertise to INSDAG in applying the CSIR-CBRI technologies specially in North-East region, preparation of scheme drawing, Interaction with client for finalizing the proposals, submission of working drawing, specifications and cost estimates for the projects undertaken by INSDAG on payment basis, which will be mutually agreed from job to job.
