India International Science Festival (IISF-2023) was organized by the Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Department of Space, Department of Atomic Energy, Vijnana Bharti and Government of Haryana at the campus of Translational Health Science and Technology Institute (THSTI) and Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) of Department of Biotechnology, Faridabad during January 17-20, 2024. The theme of IISF 2023 was "Science and Technology Public Outreach in Amrit Kaal". The event was formally inaugurated by Dr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister for Science & Technology.
