1. The completed tender form (Annexure-I) with e-waste dismantler or recycler registered with Central/ State Pollution Control Board license certificate (PQ Criteria), sealed and signed by Authorized Signatory of the Company, to be submitted on GeM portal by the bidder on or before 31/10/2025 at 03:00 PM. Further Qualified bidder also need to submit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 57000/- in form of DD only which must reach this office on or before date as per GeM Portal. Please note that EMD of unsuccessful bidder will be returned after finalization of successful bidder & EMD of the successful bidder will be returned after submission of the amount towards disposal of material and successful lifting of the material along with submission of certificate as per annexure II. CBRI will not pay any interest on the EMD amount submitted by the Bidder.

- 2. Quotations will be opened as per the schedule defined in the GeM bid document and sale order will be issued to **Highest Quoted (H1) bidder.**
- 3. The tender schedule should be filled in both figures and words in legible handwriting (Capital Letters). In case of discrepancy, between amount written in words and figures, the amount written in words will be taken into consideration.
- 4. Bidders must submit a notarized copy of the valid registration certificates issued by the State (or Union Territory) Pollution Control Board (SPCB) and produce it at the time of taking delivery of the materials, failing which their bid will be liable for rejection. In case of lead acid batteries, used/ waste oils and nonferrous metal wastes, in addition to submitting necessary valid registration from the SPCB, the bidder

In case of a sale involving inter-state movement of goods, the buyer shall also submit an NOC from the concerned SPCB, with whom the buyer is registered, to the seller before taking delivery, failing which the buyer will be responsible for the consequences and the seller shall take further decisions may be deemed fit.

  - (c) Sale of e-waste shall be governed by E-Waste (Management) Rules,2016 or as amended from time to time;
- 6. Ineligible/Incomplete tenders are liable for rejection.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the e-auction or advertisement issued on the description and particulars of material for sale, the sale is on 'as-is-where-is' basis only and the principle of caveatemptor (let the buyer be aware) will apply. "As is where is" means that the description/ quality/quantity indicated are approximate and the seller does not give any assurance or guarantee that the material will strictly adhere to the advertisement or e-auction. All items shall be taken delivery of from the site by the successful bidders, with its faults and errors in description, if any. Neither can the sale be invalidated nor the bidder make any claim/ compensation, whatsoever, on account of any defect in description or deficiency in the quantity and quality. The seller reserves the right to accept/reject and cancel any bid, amend the quantity under any lot or withdraw any lot at any stage before or after acceptance of bid/issue of acceptance letter/sale order/delivery order/deposit of the full sale value by the bidder, without assigning any reason thereof and the value of such material, if paid for, shall be refundable. The seller shall not be responsible for damage/loss to bidders on account of such withdrawal at any stage from the sale.
- 10. Any statutory variations in the rate of taxes/duties are to be borne by the purchaser. The actual GST rates as applicable on the date of issuance of sale letter shall be payable by the successful

If the purchaser is not able to lift the material within the free delivery period, groundrent@0.5 (half) per cent of the sale value per day shall be levied.
- **15.** The items shall remain, in every aspect, at the risk of the buyer from the time of acceptance of his offer. The seller will not undertake any liability whatsoever for the safe custody, protection or preservation after the sale has been confirmed. Lots are put up for sale, subject to change by nature's wear and tear. No complaint regarding the quality or description of the materials sold will be entertained once the bid has been accepted.
- 16. No picking, choosing, sorting, welding, cutting or breaking of goods or materials sold will be permitted unless written permission is granted on case to case basis. In used/waste oil, separation of oil and water, and soon, shall not be allowed at the site. If any foreign materials are found to be mixed in the lot, other than the items included in the auction catalogue and acceptance letter/sale order, the seller reserves the right to remove the material at the time of delivery. The buyer shall not be entitled to re-sell an item, lot or part of a lot while the goods are still lying within

- the premises of the seller and any such sale or assignment of the buyer's right to the material sold in an auction will not be recognized. All documents for releasing materials will be made out in the name of the buyer only.
- 17. The material will be delivered only to the successful bidder or his authorized representatives against the presentation of the buyer's identity proof. If the successful bidder desires to authorize a representative or an agent to accept delivery, the bidder shall produce a suitable power of attorney or authorization letter for each lot separately, duly attested, by a notary public authorizing his representative or agent to lift the material from the seller.
- **18.** The seller will not be, in any way, responsible for failure to deliver the material due to causes beyond his control such as a strike, lockout, and cessation of work by laborers, shortened hours, act of God or other causes or other contingencies whatsoever. The buyer shall not be entitled to cancel the contract and the period of delivery shall automatically be extended proportionately.
- **19.** Materials sold but not removed within the specified date will become the property of the seller and it will have the right to dispose of such goods in any manner as he deems fit without any notice.
- 20. In case of failure to deposit the full amount quoted or withdrawal of the Bid by successful bidder, CBRI may reject the offer of the successful bidder and its EMD shall be forfeited. Further CBRI may take appropriate action against the bidder including Blacklisting of the Firm and rejection of tender.
- 21. The successful bidder after depositing the amount quoted in the bid and accepted by the CBRI in full should remove the materials at their own cost from CBRI premises within 30 days of issuance of order.
- 22. If the successful bidder is unable to lift the material within the stipulated period of i.e. 30 days, penalty may be charged as per guidelines of GeM.
- 23. The materials being disposed of are to be treated in line with applicable rules/notifications
  - /guidelines etc. as may be prescribed by the Govt. The successful Bidder shall be responsible to ensure this after auction.
- 24. It would be the responsibility of the bidder for safe transit of the e-waste from CBRI premises to bidder location. In case of any untoward incident happened during transition of e-waste, the bidder should be held sole responsible for the loss/ consequences.
- 25. The Institute reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders at any point without assigning any reason and the decision of the Director CBRI will be final.
- 26. The successful bidder has to submit the certificate (as per **Annexure-II**) duly sealed and signed by Authorized Signatory of the Company on their letter head stating that the material is disposed off as per e-Waste disposal guidelines in force otherwise suitable action will be initiated.

- 27. CBRI will return the EMD of the successful bidder only after completion of material lifting and submission of disposal certificate as per Annexure-II of the RFQ document.
- 28. No items once disposed to the successful bidder, shall be taken back in any conditions whatsoever.

29. The Bids should remain valid for the period of 90 days after the last date for submission of bid prescribed. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected as non- responsive. The Institute may seek extension of bid validity, if required.
