However, the note states that the post will be re-advertised due to poor response. I wish to clearly state that if the post is re-advertised and I am treated as a fresh candidate, I will become ineligible due to the maximum age limit, despite having already met all essential qualifications and being found suitable by the Screening Committee. This would be procedurally unfair, as the decision to re-advertise is administrative and not due to any deficiency in my eligibility or documents. I therefore request confirmation that my current recommendation will remain valid and that I will be considered for the interview stage without re-applying. I hold a Ph.D in Architecture (Energy Efficiency), M.Arch from IIT Roorkee, over 19 years of relevant academic and professional experience, multiple SCI-indexed publications, and have been honoured with the National Award to Teachers 2023 by the Hon'ble President of India. I request a confirmation to avoid ambiguity regarding my candidature. Thank you for your kind attention.	The candidate is the sole candidate screened in to be called for interview for post code 1. As per Standing Instruction of CSIR the minimum 3 candidates should be eligible for calling for interview against 01 post. Since on Screening of the 09 applications received for the post code no. 1 only 02 candidates found eligible hence, the committee recommends that matter may be referred to RAB. The Screening Committee is not authorized to comment on future Advertisement. Hence, the representation stands invalid.

The rejection letter cites non-fulfilment of Criteria 1, 3, and 4. I respectfully submit the following grounds for reconsideration: 1) Criteria 1 – Ph.D. in Engineering in Architecture or equivalent I hold a Ph.D. (2017) from NIT Jaipur, with a dissertation titled “Strength and durability of concrete containing discarded crumb tyre rubber.” (Attachment 1) This research falls directly within the domain of construction materials, durability studies, and sustainable infrastructure, which are equally core areas in Architecture Engineering departments across India and abroad. Therefore, my qualification fulfills the spirit and intent of the criterion, and rejecting it on narrow nomenclature grounds would be inconsistent with academic equivalence principles. 2) Criteria 3 – Master's degree in Architecture or equivalent My Master's degree in Construction Engineering and Management (Anna University, 2012) is academically and functionally equivalent to an M.Arch, as evidenced by 50–60% syllabus overlap with M.Arch curricula at reputed institutions such as the University of Mumbai, Dr. M.G.R. University Chennai, SPA Vijayawada, and VTU Belagavi. (Attachment 2) The attached syllabus comparison substantiates this equivalence. It is a settled principle in higher education policy that substantive academic content prevails over nomenclature. Hence, my degree squarely meets the equivalence requirement of the advertised post. 3) Criteria 4 – Ph.D. topic in relevant areas The doctoral research topic, as mentioned, is highly relevant to Architecture and Civil Engineering, addressing sustainability, performance, and durability of building materials. This falls under the core research mandate of CBRI Roorkee, thereby fulfilling the relevance requirement of the criterion. PRAYER: In view of the above submissions, I most respectfully request the Selection Committee to: Kindly reconsider my application for Post Code 1. Take into account the equivalence of my qualifications as justified above. Restore my candidature and shortlist me for the position of Principal Scientist. It was stated in the screening list that I didn't meet the screening criteria points 1,3, and 4. The following is my response/clarification for that. Response to Screening Criteria: 1. Meeting the essential educational qualifications with documentary proof as notified (Ph.D. (Sciences)in Geology/ Applied Geology/ Geosciences/Earth Sciences/Physical Sciences or its equivalent with documentary proof as per 2(g) of Advertisement Reply: It is an essential criterion for the application. I have attached an equivalency certificate from AcSIR stating that my Ph.D. is in Physical Sciences and its equivalent the Geophysics 2. Experience of 2 years in relevant areas with specialization in Landslide Disaster related studies as per the essential criteria and in line with 2(h) of Advertisement Reply: Fulfilled (as noted) 3. Master's Degree (sciences) in Geology/ Applied Geology/ Geosciences/ Earth Sciences/ Geological Technology or its equivalent with documentary proof as per 2(g) of advertisement Reply: I have completed my M.Sc in space physics, which is a science stream associated with earth science. In addition, I am also attaching my Ph.D. course curricular certificate, from which it is clear that I have studied and qualified in basic subjects of earth sciences. In addition, I have worked and published research articles in Resistivity, gravity, seismology, seismic, GPS, groundwater, climate studies, etc., in internationally reputed journals, which also indicate knowledge in earth sciences. As it is sought under desirable qualifications, I would be grateful if you could consider my experience rather than the certificate. 4. Ph.D. topic in the relevant areas with specialization in landslide disaster-related studies Reply: I agree, my Ph.D. is in Physical Sciences, focusing on the development of novel methods for de-noising and data gap filling of seismic data. I have been using the methods developed, as well as signal processing techniques used during my Ph.D., to process and understand the seismic data of landslides for their detection. This enabled me to develop novel spectral attribute-based landslide waveform discrimination methods for real-time automatic detection of landslides (Rekapalli et al., 2024, GRL; Rao et al., 2021 and Cook et al., 2021, Science). In addition, I have been guiding a Ph.D. student, particularly on the Development of Automatic Machine Learning algorithms for the real-time detection of the landslide seismic signal for the early warning of the Associated Mass Flow event. As you are aware, guiding a student on the entirely novel aspect (global scope) of landslide early warning requires more domain knowledge than doing a Ph.D. under a guide. From the above, it is clear that I have versatile knowledge than a Ph.D. candidate in seismic network-based landslide/hazard-related research. I respectfully submit that my extensive experience, research contributions, and leadership in closely related areas make me highly qualified for the role. I request a reconsideration of my application based on the following key facts: 1. Relevant Research Experience and Publications: Although my PhD focused on Seismic Signal Processing, my work has directly intersected with landslide studies through seismic detection methods. I have authored publications in prestigious journals such as *Science and Geophysical Research Letters (GRL) on the seismic detection of landslides for early warning of associated cascaded events. These contributions demonstrate my expertise in applying seismic signal processing techniques to landslide-related hazards, bridging the gap between my formal qualification and the position's requirements. 2. Supervision of Advanced Research in the Field: I have successfully guided one PhD student to completion, with their thesis centered on relevant geophysical applications. Additionally, another PhD student under my guidance is on the verge of submitting their thesis in the coming months. This work focuses on developing a machine learning model for the automatic detection of landslide signals in continuous seismic data, aimed at establishing a seismic network-based early warning system for cascaded hazards associated with landslides. My mentorship in this area underscores my deep involvement and leadership in landslide detection research. 3. Project Leadership and Funding Achievements: As a Co-Principal Investigator, I have been playing a key role in two major projects funded by prominent organizations: - A DRDO-funded project worth ~6.7 crore, focused on seismic network-based landslide detection for early warning of associated cascaded events. - An NTPC-funded project worth ~19.7 crore, similarly emphasizing seismic detection methodologies for landslide hazards. In both projects, I have been instrumental in design, implementation, and execution, leveraging my expertise in geophysical datasets, coding, and algorithm development. These initiatives have resulted in tangible advancements in early warning systems, aligning directly with the demands of the Senior Scientist role. Furthermore, my broader academic and professional profile includes: a) Guidance of several M.Tech and M.Sc students in their dissertations, fostering the next generation of researchers in geophysics and related fields. b) Recognition as an Assistant Professor at AcSIR, where I contribute to teaching and research in geophysical sciences. c) A strong publication record in reputed national and international journals, reflecting my proficiency in handling complex geophysical data and developing innovative algorithms. The rejection overlooks the interdisciplinary nature of modern scientific research, where expertise in signal processing is crucial for advancing landslide hazard mitigation. I kindly request that my application be reevaluated in light of this representation.
